





Study Description: Evaluation of the

Population Health Management Initiative

The American Institutes for Research (AIR) is working with the University of Chicago and Kaiser Permanente to understand how health centers like yours are implementing the Population Health Management Initiative and how the initiative is impacting the experiences of providers and staff.

CONFIDENTIALITY: Everything that you say during this conversation will be kept anonymous. Your name and the names of any individuals that you mention will not appear on any report or other publications, and the recording of the conversation, along with any notes, will be stored on a secure server that is only accessible to members of our research team. The reports we produce will summarize the information gathered and will never be associated with an identifiable individual. We will destroy the interview recording from this study 5 years after the study ends.

PARTICIPANT RIGHTS: Taking part in this study is voluntary. If you choose not to participate, your role in the PHMI will not be affected.

CONSENT: There are no right or wrong answers to the questions we will ask in the interview. You may choose not to answer every question, and we can stop the discussion at any time.

INCENTIVES: Each provider or staff member who completes an interview will receive a \$100 gift card as a token of our appreciation. Our discussion will take approximately 60 minutes. We would like to record the session for note-taking accuracy. However, we will not record if there are any concerns about the recording, and instead will take notes.
